Requirements:

1. **Edge Classes and Mass:** There are 17 exciting Edge Classes planned for 2018-19 and 3 other mandatory nights for students and parents (see below). These amazing middle school teaching classes will be held from 2:20-3:20 on Tuesday. A student can miss no more than 2 classes (excluding the mandatory Sunday classes - see below).
2. **Three Mandatory Edge Sundays for Adults and Teens and Teaching Mass:** There will be four Edge Sunday classes this year, of which three are mandatory for all 7th graders and at least one of their parents. Sign-ins will be done to ensure attendance. The dates are as follows: 10/28/2018, 12/2/2018, 2/10/2019, and 3/24/2019. Everyone will come to the 11:30 mass that day and then have a presentation following Mass from 12:45-2. Also on November 4th, we will have a teaching Mass at all masses and we ask all parents to attend the 11:30AM Mass. Thank you in advance for your cooperation!
3. **Weekly Mass Attendance:** Parents and children are expected to attend mass every weekend. The Eucharist is the life of the church, and it is imperative that we gather as God's people, united in our faith, to celebrate the sacrifice of Jesus. Not attending Mass, undermines everyone's efforts to mold our youth into Christians.

What are Edge Nights? Seaside Edge is Hingham's very own 7th grade youth ministry program where kids are invited to come together on Tuesdays for Edge events. Its goal is to engage the youth through prayer, ice-breakers, and enthusiastic teachings and above all, relationship building.
