Orientation Night for incoming 9th and 10th grade parents and students is from 7:30 - 8:30 PM at Resurrection Church on Wednesday, September 8th.

Mission Statement: *As ambassadors for Christ, our mission is to reflect the love of Christ to all who enter our doors, expressing excitement and enthusiasm for the opportunity to share our church home and to welcome all visitors in such a way that they would be transformed from strangers into friends.*

Requirements:

1. **Life Nights and Holy Hour:** 12 Life Nights (which include the 3 mandatory nights) and 3 Holy Hours which take place every Thursdays at Resurrection from 8:30-9:30 PM.
 2. **Three Mandatory Life Nights for Adults and Teens:** There will be three Mandatory Life Nights this year for all teens in our Confirmation program and at least one parent. Sign-ins will be done to ensure attendance. The dates are as follows: 10/24/2021, 12/5/2022, and 2/27/2022. Thank you in advance for your cooperation!
 3. **Attend Weekly Mass:** Life Teen Mass takes place every Sunday from 5:30-6:30 PM at Resurrection Church. We strongly urge parents to attend that mass with their teens. If an individual isn't able to attend the Life Teen Mass on a particular Sunday, we ask that you email Alyssa Gendreau at agendreau@hinghamcatholic.org
 4. **10th Grade Retreat:** Attend 1 Retreat to be held on Saturday, October 16th from 9 AM to 4 PM at Resurrection. If your child is not able to attend this retreat, they may go on a mission trip, Discipleship Week, CAMPS, or March for Life as a substitute. See below for more information.
 5. **Service Events:** Students are asked to attend a minimum of 5 service events with Seaside Life Teen during the year. Service opportunities will be provided, and usually will be held on Saturday mornings. For more information, please check the website for an outlined schedule of service opportunities
1. **Attend Two Mandatory Confirmation Classes:** There are two mandatory Confirmation classes that take place during 10th grade (Thursday, November 4th from 6:30 to 8:00 pm, and Thursday, April 7th 6:30 to 8:00 pm at Resurrection). There will be a Catechism review trivia quiz during these classes. The exam can be found online, seasidelifeteen.org, under Resurrection Confirmation.
 2. **Practice with Sponsors and Paperwork for Confirmation:** Your sponsor is someone who is a Confirmed and practicing Catholic and someone who can be a mentor in the faith. The date for practice, confession and prayer is Friday, May 6th at Resurrection Church from 7:15 PM - 9:30 PM (date subject to change). More information about necessary paperwork will be made available throughout the year. Copy of Baptismal Certificate (if baptized or received First Communion anywhere besides Resurrection), Online Sponsor and Online Confirmation Form **due February 1st, 2022.**

When: **Late April/Early May** at Resurrection Church. You will receive an email from Jo-Ann Sullivan, our Confirmation Director, when this information becomes available.

What are Life Nights? Our weekly youth ministry event known as Life Night takes place from 6:30 - 8 PM following the 5:30 PM Life Teen mass on Sundays at Resurrection Church. Life Nights are the primary time each week where social activities, current issues, or catechesis will be given in an engaging and relevant way. They are also times of fellowship, catechesis and community. Beyond Life Nights, this dynamic program will also be participating in outings, mission trips and much more! All of our events are open to everyone in grades 9-12! We invite you to check out our schedule of upcoming events on our website, seasidelifeteen.org.

Requirement Breakdown:

- **12 Life Nights/Online Small Groups:** In order for your child to get the most out of our program, we are asking that they strive to attend consecutive weeks. For example, our curriculum topics this year are set up in sets of 4-6 weeks with each Sunday building on the last (see below). There

will also be 3 mandatory Life Nights (see above) for all students in the Confirmation program and at least one of their parents. Attendance will be taken.

- **3 Thursday Night Holy Hours:** Holy Hours are a time of adoration with guided meditation, music and the opportunity for confession. They take place every Thursday at Resurrection Church from 8:30-9:30 PM. **Students must check in with Alyssa at the end of Holy Hour to receive credit.**

Life Night Descriptions:

- ❑ **Alive and Dangerous** → This series contains Life Nights on our desire for God and how we find fulfillment and happiness in Him. The topics covered include our call toward love, substitutes of God's love, counterfeits of God's love, and holiness.
- ❑ **The Promise** → This Life Night series immerses teens in these familiar narratives and offers the opportunity to process these stories as real life experiences. It also challenges teens to live lives of prayer and discipleship.
- ❑ **Sex Positive** → Sex Positive takes on modern views on sexuality. It brings to light and challenges the messages we receive through modern culture and particularly the mass media. It explores the Church's teaching on the nuptial meaning of the body, the purpose of sex, self-giving love (free, total, faithful, fruitful) and how to faithfully live out self-giving love and chastity in all vocations. Furthermore, it accomplishes this through the lens of truth, beauty, and goodness and an understanding that we (including our sexuality) are created "very good" by God.
- ❑ **Vital** → In this series, we will enter more deeply into the life and mission of the Holy Spirit, the fruits and gifts He offers us, and discover how we can be more open to His presence and power in our lives
- ❑ **Holy Spirit and Evangelization** → A two part series presented by Father Matt on how to internalize the gifts of the Holy Spirit and share them with the world as disciples of Jesus.
